

How to choose a paver

A great paving job does not cut corners

If your driveway needs repair. Find a local paving contractor. Don't fall for pitches delivered door-to-door.

Verify that the contractor you hire is registered in Connecticut as a home improvement contractor by contacting the Department of Consumer Protection.

Get the contractor's certificate of insurance liability and workman's compensation coverage from the contractor's insurance provider.

Check with your town for any required permits and have them in place before work begins.

- Have your contractor provide all warranties in writing.
- Always get a signed and dated contract for paving work, since it will protect you from potential damages or misunderstandings. According to state law, the following must be included in writing:
 - The date the contract was signed
 - A start date and end date for the job
 - The price (you can request that labor and material be broken out separately)
 - The contractor's name, address and home improvement contractor number
 - A 3-day Notice of Cancellation that allows you 72 hours to change your mind, along with clear instructions on how to contact the company to cancel that contract.

Department of consumer protection Warns: Paving Scammers have Surfaced in Connecticut

HARTFORD, April 23 - When the warm weather arrives, it leads to the early arrival of flowers, insects—— and even paving scammers, the Department for Consumer Protection reported today,

"Spring and summer are prime seasons for bogus door-to-door offers, so consumers need to be wary," Commissioner William Rubenstein said today. "We've learned that traveling pavers have already started their rounds in the state, and more fly-by-night operators offering chimney repair and magazine sales can't be far behind. It's important that consumers be extra careful and vigilant. Don't let anyone in your home for any reason unless you're sure you know who they are— scammers have been known to commit burglaries if given the opportunity."

Traveling pavers visit the Northeast most years, pushing underpriced, inferior driveway paving and sealing services. Bargain-minded consumers are taken in by these smooth-talking scam artists, losing their money, and often being left with a pile of rubble where their driveways used to be.

Crews often drive unmarked utility trucks and vans; their salespeople go door-to-door and their sales pitch usually involvers "leftover" asphalt from a nearby job that's available immediately, at a bargain price. Other hallmarks of the paving scam includes high pressure sales tactics, hap-hazard contracts and a request for payment in cash or personal check made out to cash.

Known for striking quickly and then disappearing, traveling pavers surface days later in a different area, making them difficult to catch. Local police departments and the Department of Consumer Protection share information and often collaborate in tracking leads called in by savvy consumers.

"If something or someone seems suspicious in your neighborhood, please report it to your local police department."Rubenstein said. He offered the following additional tips.

"Since the law gives home owners three days to change their mind, no work should start until last least three days until after the contract is signed." Rubenstein said. "Don't be pressured by anyone who needs to start right away."

How to care for your new driveway

Congratulations on choosing Deziel Paving as your paving contractor.

Here are a few things you can do to care for your new asphalt driveway.



• Asphalt needs 6-12 months to harden and cure, until then it will remain somewhat soft and pliable. You can walk on your new driveway immediately, but keep automobile traffic off it for at least 3 full days, up to a week in hotter weather.

• Your new asphalt will soften and harden as temperatures rise and fall. Watering down your drive will cool and temporarily harden the asphalt, but is not necessary. If you do water it it, do not be alarmed if you see some soap suds appearing. This is a reaction between the diesel fuel found in the asphalt and a high chlorine content found in some city water. Although every effort is made to avoid puddles in your driveway, some small ones are inevitable depending on the natural slope and drainage of your ground.

• Your new driveway will be scarred by cars starting too fast, pulling in too quickly, turning around in tight areas and just plain driving too fast.

• During the time your driveway is curing, do not park in the same spot each day and avoid turning your steering wheel back and forth when your car is not moving. Doing these things can result in indentations and scarring of the asphalt.

• Do not use jack stands or car ramps without a piece of plywood placed under them to distribute the weight.

• Excessive weight from large heavy vehicles can depress your new driveway. Keep oil, concrete and any other heavy trucks off of your new asphalt. If storing a camper or boat for a long period of time, place plywood under the tongue jack and under the tires.

• The following can cause holes and depressions in your new driveway: lawn chairs, bike and motorcycle kickstands, pointy high heel shoes, sports shoes with cleats.

• Should a weed grow up through the asphalt, spray it with a weed killer.


• Because the edges of the driveway are the weakest part, avoid driving on the edges as they will crack and crumble in time. We recommend building up the sides of the drive with topsoil to approximately 1" from the top to allow room for sod growth and water drainage. This will support the edges and enhance the appearance after grass has grown.

• Avoid spilling gasoline, oil, anti-freeze, power steering or transmission fluid on your asphalt. Should a spill occur, make a solution of mild dish detergent mixed with water (we find Dawn works well) and clean the area with a push broom. If a hole is left by any of these fluids it should be filled with cold patch.

• Any cracks that may develop in asphalt due to the contraction and expansion of the asphalt over the winter, or for any other reasons, should be filled with crack filler. This can be purchased from your local building supple store or can be professionally applied by a contractor.

• Deziel Paving does not recommend seal coating of your asphalt, but if you choose to sealcoat your driveway do not do so any sooner that 2 years from the time of paving.
